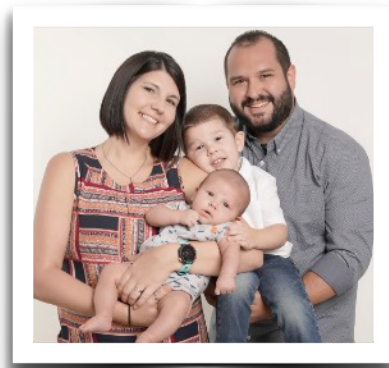

Greetings from Bangkok! The last few months of ministry here have been filled with important milestones, lots of gospel planting and watering, and planning for the future. Praise the Lord that we've seen growth of believers, the increased understanding of those whom we are witnessing to, and lots of new opportunities to serve in the future.

In August, we celebrated the 28th Anniversary of Bangjak Baptist Church. We had an amazing day with a packed house, a special meal, and a time to honor those who serve in the church. It was a blessing to preach and remind our church not to forget its purpose. The building was so full that we had to get creative with seating! We're thankful for the people, the leadership team, and the missionaries that we get to serve with at Bangjak.



Recently, we welcomed the first missions team to arrive since Covid. They helped our missionary team with an English Camp as well as taught an English course in local schools (we're SO thankful schools are beginning to open for outreaches there again!). As a result of these outreaches we had a great group of students attend the camp and connect with Bangjak and Bentai Baptist Churches. We also now have students from the school outreach attending services. Please be in prayer for them.

In September, we served with Bentai Baptist Church to host a fellowship of pastors and missionaries from all over Thailand. We were grateful to serve and fellowship with these godly men and ladies.
